

### **Student Disciplinary Guidelines for Sexual Misconduct**

These guidelines are meant to inform expectations about how discipline may be assigned in sexual misconduct cases between students at Tufts University. These guidelines should not be considered mandatory, as decision-makers have discretion in the interpretation and implementation of these guidelines when deciding actual cases. In particular, adjudicators may decide to include educational components to any or all disciplinary decisions.
