



In April 2022, the third iteration of the **Tufts Attitudes about Sexual Conduct Survey** (TASCS) was delivered to all Tufts undergraduate and graduate students. Based on student feedback from previous TASCS administered in 2015 and 2017, the 2022 TASCS was issued to students via a general Qualtrics survey link instead of a unique link (as in 2015) or one where students accessed the survey using their student ID numbers (2017). This meant the Tufts Office of Institutional Research (OIR) could not send automated reminder messages with links to students who did not complete the survey during the 28 days it was active. In addition, because of the Covid-19 pandemic, all mandatory university surveys were paused and when students came back to campus, they experienced survey fatigue as a result of multiple surveys being delivered to them in Spring 2022.

Upon review, the demographics of returned surveys were not representative of all our campuses and further analysis of the final results revealed an estimated response rate of 4.3% which OIR determined to be statistically inadequate to report upon. OIR and OEO will be running this survey again in Spring 2023.
